# **Resume Tips**

MILITARY TO CIVILIAN TERMINOLOGY

Do your best to replace military specific systems with civilian language descriptors.

- AVOID ACRONYMS

  Make your resume easy to understand by avoiding acronyms that may cause confusion.
- PAST AND PRESENT ROLES

  Use present tense for positions currently held and past tense for previous roles.
- EVERY DETAIL COUNTS!

  Always have someone proofread your resume for spelling and grammatical errors.
- UTILIZE BULLET POINTS
  Use bullet points to ensure succinct and relevant information.
